## Brunello di Montalcino

*Sangiovese 100%*

13% Alcohol

Clear, purple-red in color, with good depth and "legs" indicating the certain structure. Intensely perfumed on the nose, with fruit aromas including blackberries, black currants and cherries a dominant theme. In the mouth the wine is full bodied with tremendous depth and richness, attractive fruit and well balanced acidity.

The wine remains in Slovenian oak casks for at least three years before bottling.

## Rosso di Montalcino

*Sangiovese 100%*

12.5% Alcohol

The "baby" Brunello. The second wine of the Castello. Same grape variety, 100% Sangiovese grosso. Slightly lower in alcohol, this young "Brunello" is slightly lighter, more fruity and ready to enjoy.

The wine is barrel aged in oak for six months before bottling.
